The student interns, each of whom received academic credit for their internship, spent their time in the SEU's Promotions and Programming departments supervised by our SEU's Promotions Director and a Producer. The interns learned about promotions, marketing, advertising and programming by both working closely with SEU personnel and assisting with Station events and promotions. In addition, the interns were taught how to use tools and programs commonly employed in the broadcast industry. Following their interships, our SEU hired four (4) of the interns as part-time Remote Techs/On Air.
